# **ELECT YOUR LEADERS**

General Notice 4 of 2022 was sent to all registered social workers, social auxiliary workers, child and youth care workers and auxiliary child and youth care workers on the SACSSP's election for the 5th South African Council for Social Service Professions, 5th Professional Board for Social Work and 4th Professional Board for Child and Youth Care Work elections with a polling day of 16 May 2022 as announced in Board Notice 248 of 2022 published in Government Gazette 46288 of 29 April 2022 has all the details

The election of Members will happen for the first time through prescribed electronic election procedures - an electronic/online Ballot Paper that will be completed and submitted online using a secure link. Voters also have the option to participate in the election using the manual election procedures by casting a paper Ballot Paper.

CHECK YOUR EMAIL: On 29 April 2022 web-based links were sent to eligible voters' electronic mail (email) addresses that will direct him or her the specific electronic Ballot Paper. Verify this web-link immediately - if for any reason it does not direct you to the electronic Ballot Paper inform the Returning Officer immediately, but not later than 6 May 2022, in writing to email address elections@sacssp. co.za as to allow for the correct link to be sent. No requests after 6 May 2022 will be accommodated.

CHECK MAIL: Paper Ballot Papers, for those who require or requested these, were dispatched by 3 May 2022 to the postal address as on the Register. If such a voter has not received a paper ballot paper by 6 May 2022, he or she must contact the Returning Officer at elections@sacssp.co.za immediately.
