On the 17 June 2022 an online session was held on how to access and navigate the New Online Registration System. This well-attended webinar which was streamed live and was attended by 275 stakeholders including students, and had 136 views on YouTube. The audience experienced the system to be very easy and userfriendly. LIVE registrations and issuing of practice cards were processed and multiple attendees were able to complete their applications online.
