NOT JUST ANOTHER WEEK

The Registrations Department conducted a roadshow in the Western Cape from 20 to 24 June 2022, in concert with the Western Cape Department of Social Development and some NGOs offering child and youth care services. A presentation on the Child and Youth Care Amended Regulations (2019) and code of ethics was delivered to the various attendees. Below are the statistics for the different leg of the roadshow:

- 20 June - Mfecane NPC in Vredenburg: 18 registrations of child and youth care workers were completed, 18 certificates and 19 receipts were issued and 1 receipt issued to a social worker.
- 21 June - Clan William Secure Care centre: 37 registrations of child and youth care workers were completed, 37 certificates and 38 receipts issued and 1 receipt issued to a social worker.
- 22 June - Lielibloem House Child and Youth Care Centre: 24 registrations of child and youth care workers were completed, 24 certificates and 27 receipts issued, additional 9 certificates were issued to child and youth care work learners and 4 receipts issued to social workers.
- 23 June - ROAR (De Novo): 85 registrations of child and youth care workers were completed, 85 certificates and 72 receipts issued, additional 2 receipt were issued to social workers. A total of 300 people attended the briefing session and demonstration of the online registration system.
- 24 June - Youth for Christ in George: 3 receipts issued to child and youth care workers and 4 receipt issued to social workers.

On 21 June, the Registrar presented a CPD accredited information session on 'Technology Supported Social Work Services' using MS Teams to the Office of the Chief Family Advocate in KwaZulu Natal, Gauteng and Eastern Cape. On 28 June another session was conducted for Northern Cape, Free State and Mpumalanga teams.
