RENEW YOUR LICENSE TO PRACTICE

Happy New Year! The SACSSP's office opened on 3 January 2023 and we are ready for the new year. It is encouraging to see that registrants are paying their annual fees for 2023/2024. The mounts payable for registration and annual fees for 2023/2024 are available on our website www. sacssp.co.za under Registration (Payments - Fees payable). Please bear with us if you received an invoice and you have already paid. The finance division is in the process of updating the payments received. Registrants who are up to date with payments of annual fees and or other fees due to the SACSSP will be issued with receipts in due course.

At the start of the year we wish to share with you a few pointers that will assist you with paying the fees:

REGISTERED SOCIAL SERVICE PROFESSIONALS: Persons already registered with the SACSSP must quote their registration number as a reference when making a payment starting with either: 10-, 50-, 70- or 90-.

PERSONS APPLYING FOR THE FIRST TIME to register as as social worker, social auxiliary worker, child and youth care worker or auxiliary child and youth care worker (including persons who completed their studies in 2022):

IMPORTANT: Use this link to register: www.sacssponline.co.za

- 1. First sign up as new user. A confirmation email will be sent to your email address. Click on the link in the email sent to you by the system and then LOG IN.
- 2. After you have logged in successfully, you will be directed to the DASHBOARD with steps to guide you according to your registration category. Please make sure you complete this part correctly or you will not be able to proceed to the next step.
- 3. You will be requested to **upload** your required documents (ID, academic record and qualification certificate/s). Make sure all documents are certified (certification may not be older than 3 months).
- 4. After you have uploaded (attached) all your documents you will be required to make a PAYMENT. Payment options include on the registration portal via OZOW Payment or a direct payment through internet banking. Click on https://www.sacssp.co.za/payments/ for banking details.
