OUTREACH WITH A FOCUS

From 8 to 12 May 2023 the SACSSP visited the *University of Zululand*, *Durban University of Technology (DUT)* and *University of KwaZulu-Natal* in KwaZulu-Natal as part of its registration outreach to students, and attended to general enquiries of all registrants. This visit resulted in:

- the processing and approval of 322 applications for student social workers
- the processing and approval of 33 applications for student child and youth care workers
- · the processing and approval of 3 applications for social workers
- the issuing of 17 practice cards to social workers.
- the processing and approval of 107 applications for auxiliary child and youth care workers
- the issuing of 5 practice cards to child and youth care workers and 15 practice cards to auxiliary child and youth care workers.

The SACSSP's *Professional Conduct Division* presented on the social work code of ethics at EAP National Mental Health Seminar hosted by the Department of Correctional Services on 24 May 2023, and on 25 May 2023 a message of support was given at the oath taking ceremony of the 2nd year social work students at the University of Johannesburg.

National Child Protection Week 2023 is commemorated from 28 May to 4 June 2023 under a five year theme "Let us protect children during COVID-19 and beyond".
